### The challenge

To support Pakuranga College’s exceptional and innovative learning environment without online access restrictions constraining learning.

### The need

A high-speed broadband connection is an essential educational tool for Pakuranga College. Online activity is now fully integrated into their learning philosophy, as both a teaching and learning resource. After experiencing problems in the past, Pakuranga College know how critical it is to have a reliable connection and how much they depend on it.

The school also recognises that using the internet is a life skill, so teachers incorporate online elements into their classes. This allows teachers to interact with students in a way that students are familiar with, while also helping them to become more competent in the digital world.

EduNet provides Pakuranga College with:

- Ultra fast 1Gbit/s connection with other EduNet schools for instant collaboration.
- 100 Mbit/s access to rich content from a wide variety of educational content.
- From 10Mbit/s up to 100Mbit/s access to the public Internet - flexible enough to meet the particular requirements of the school and without caps that would hamper learning in the classroom.

The school gets all of this at a fixed cost, allowing teachers and students access to Vector’s EduNet network, and a reliable, high-speed broadband connection.

### Key results

EduNet gives Pakuranga College teachers and students the opportunity to access a vast range of online materials. It can connect them with other schools and other educational content providers, including libraries, universities, TVNZ, TV3, and data centers. With the high-speed broadband connection they can create and share their own educational material with online services like Elluminate and Wikispaces. In short, the possibilities are endless.

Having access to the wealth of information available online is an extremely valuable tool. Teachers and students can make use of all the resources available online using a variety of different electronic devices, regardless of their operating system (Mac OS, iOS, Windows, Android, or even Linux). This means that everyone is free to work from almost any machine, without compatibility issues getting in the way of learning.

All of the services and opportunities provided by EduNet to Pakuranga College come at a flat rate, which allows Pakuranga College to better manage its IT budget and spend. Unmetered internet access also lets them take advantage of free online services, saving them even more. In addition, instead of incurring additional costs so that each student can have 20MB of server storage, EduNet allows those students to have access to 50GB of cloud storage free of charge.
